

Southern New England Stumpage Price report.

3rd quarter, 2009

Stumpage comments:

- Didn't do any logging or buying during this period. Thank you.
- I hear "H" chip markets still going strong. No new sales started since white pine/"biomass" sale reported last time. Four sales pending, one sold 1 ½ years ago i.e logging entity needs to ____his market. We're still... (paper ripped) #5 p.s. you should re-do the 2 annoying fold lines on the back side so they're in sync with normalcy!
- No purchase of standing timber for this period.
- Markets are tight. Rapid changes in price! Wood is demanded in short time 4 price quoted.
- No purchases this quarter
- No stumpages purchased this period. Note: have not received 2009/2010 harvesters license since check on 7/3/09. Check has not been cashed.
- Landowners expect more money for firewood but heavy competition keeping price and sales down.
- No purchases this period.

- Pine and Hemlock are moving again.
- Chip prices exceed most timber species prices. Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP) eliminates most stumpage revenue to landowners.
